Preparing for Your Visit

Use this guide to get to know us, and to help you prepare for your first visit. We recommend that you bring it with you, as you'll find directions to The Regional Cancer Center, contact information, and a list of the services we provide for your convenience.

Take a look at the "to-do" list below. It is important that you gather all the information that you can, and bring it with you on your first visit.

Your Health Insurance ID Card

We will need to update our files with all of your insurance information, so bring your health insurance identification card. If your insurer requires a referral, please make sure you have obtained that referral and, if necessary, bring a copy with you.

If you do not have health insurance or if you have any questions about your insurance, you can call our Financial Advisor at 315.624.5216.

A List of Your Allergies

It is essential for your health care team to know if you have any allergies, especially to latex, iodine, or seafood. Please prepare a list of your allergies and bring it with you to your appointment.

A List of the Medications You are Taking

Your healthcare team wants to know ALL the medications you are currently taking. This includes anything over-the-counter such as pain relievers or allergy pills. We also need a list of the vitamins, minerals, herbal, or natural substances you are taking. You can bring all of your medications with you or a complete list of the medications and vitamins along with the dosage of each.
